What are the main features of Impressionism?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Impressionism is a style of painting that focuses on the effects of light and atmosphere on colours and forms. Impressionist artists often used broken brush strokes.
What are the main features of Pointillism?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pointillism is a painting technique developed by the artist George Seurat. It involves using small, painted dots to create areas of colour that together form a pattern or picture.
What are the main features of Surrealism?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Surrealistic art is characterized by dream-like visuals, the use of symbolism and collage images. Several prominent artists came from this movement, including Renee Magritte, Salvador Dali, and Max Ernst.
